How to answer your essay questions:

<u>Questions</u>	<u>How you might answer...</u>
<i>Please tell us why you are interested in Peak Education and what you are hoping to gain from participating?</i>	Talk about how the program will help you at school, with teachers or with schoolwork. Are you excited about meeting other students, events, or leadership? There is no wrong answer!
<i>What is a goal or dream you have for your future? What does success look like for you?</i>	Talk about something you want to accomplish, a job/career that interests you, or something you've always wanted to do. Talk about a time when you knew you were successful in school, at home, or doing something unique.
<i>What motivates you?</i>	This might be a person you look up to, a family member, or even someone famous. It could also be an idea, business, or organization. Maybe a famous quote/saying! Anything!
